NOTE: The master's degree must be completed within 8 years. The eight year period begins at the date of completion of the first course to be applied toward degree requirements. No course more than 8 years old at the time of graduation may be applied toward requirements for the degree. For example: If the first course on the degree plan is dated Fall 2015, the student must graduate in or before Summer 2023.
